SECTION 5311 RURAL AREA PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION

WHEREAS, the **Shelby County Commission** recognizes the need for a public transportation program; and

WHEREAS, the **Shelby County Commission** is an active member of the Birmingham Regional Paratransit Consortium, (ClasTran), created to execute the vision of the Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO), and Jefferson / Shelby Rural Transportation Steering Committee; to organize, coordinate and implement a regional public and specialized transportation service for the region; and

WHEREAS, the **Shelby County Commission** recognizes that the requirements to obtain Federal Transit Administration (FTA) Section 5311 funds through recipient, the Alabama Department of Transportation (ALDOT), requires a local match of 50% for operating expenses and 20% for administration, capital expenses and the purchase of transportation services for rural transportation (Section 5311); and

WHEREAS, the **Shelby County Commission** recognizes that the local match will be a shared cost with other participating agencies, counties and municipalities being responsible for providing an appropriate allocation of local non-federal funds to secure the operating of Section 5311 Rural Transportation Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the **Shelby County Commission** hereby commits the amount of **\$130,733.00** within Fiscal Year 2023 County's general fund for ClasTran to use as the applicable local match for the capital, administrative and operational expenditures under the Section 5311 Rural Public Transportation Program during Fiscal Year 2023. The County Manager is directed to perform any necessary actions associated with these programs.

WHEREAS, The Alabama Legislature recently passed alcohol laws that resulted in the creation of two (2) license types to be issued by the Alabama ABC Board. The new license types have been established by the Board, but now require local action regarding Shelby County wet county alcohol license fees; and,

WHEREAS, ACT #2022-360 Hospitality Management Program is specifically for any state university that operates a school or college that offers bachelors or associate degrees in Hospitality Management, Hospitality Sciences, Hotel Management, Event Management, Restaurant Management, or Culinary Sciences. A Hospitality Management Program license may be issued to the state university upon whose property the licensed premises is located or to a third party licensee of the board that has contracted with the state university to perform the licensed activities on the premises located on the state university campus. A state university means a public two-year institution of higher education that has its own campus police department or a four-year institution of higher education; and,

WHEREAS, ACT #2022-432 Food or Beverage Truck is specifically to provide for a food or beverage truck license in Class 1 municipalities that would allow a food or beverage truck to sell alcoholic beverages for consumption in open containers within an area designated by the municipal governing authority within an established entertainment district; and to require the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board to adopt rules; and,

WHEREAS, Class 1 municipality is defined as all cities with a population of 300,000 inhabitants or more; and,

WHEREAS, ACT #2022-432 for a class 1 municipality with an established entertainment district does not apply in Shelby County.

2022 Marked and Unmarked Sheriff's Office Vehicle Equipment and
Installation**

The Shelby County Sheriff's Office shall have the sole right to determine if all requirements have been met.

The winning bidder must be ready to start installation of all vehicles within 30 days of notification that they have been awarded the bid for these vehicles and within 30 days of delivery and receipt of any future vehicles and equipment for the vehicles. This will be contingent upon delivery of vehicles from the manufacturers; the Sheriff's Office will provide projected delivery dates to the bidder as provided by vehicle manufacturers upon request. Installer must be able to complete a minimum of 3 vehicles per week from the start date. If the winning bidder fails to deliver complete services during this established time frame punitive damages will be assessed. If the project is not complete by the third day past the estimated end date, a two percent reduction in the total project cost will be deducted from the final bill. In addition for every seven days following that the project is not complete another two percent (cumulative) reduction in the total project cost will be deducted from the final bill.




